



On Sunday, October 16, 2021, The Oregon Community Theatre (OCT) Board of Directors voted to follow the Oregon City School (OCS) Policy for masking. In an email sent to families Wednesday, October 27, 2021 at 4:36 pm, Hal Gregory, Superintendent, OCS. Highlights of that email are below and the full message can be found [here](#).

Beginning Thursday, October 28, 2021, OCS will implement a mask optional policy for staff, students and visitors. Masks or facial coverings are no longer required on a daily basis in all school buildings and offices throughout Oregon City Schools.

This policy change is a direct result of the recent quarantine guidance update by the Ohio Department of Health (ODH). See the full guidance [here](#):

As we move to a more typical school experience without the mask requirement, please know, OCS will continue to monitor COVID numbers and the impact it is having in our schools.

For those parents who are concerned about no longer having the mask requirement, please encourage your children to continue wearing a mask.

Masks will be optional but recommended for OCT personnel and patrons. We will continue to monitor the progress of COVID in the county and any changes to the OCS policy moving forward and make adjustments as necessary.
